B. Elite Mount


## Elite Mount Installation




**Parts List** 

After disassembling your AK using your owners manual, begin by placing the elite mount as seen in (Figure 1a) until seated against the receiver.



Using a paint pen, mark a circle onto the mount by placing the pen through the existing hole in the receiver as seen in (Figure 1b). Make sure the mount is held tight and flush to the receiver when making your mark.




Before proceeding make sure you remove the mount from the receiver. Using a 5/32" drill bit, drill through the marked hole about 1/2". Place the mount into the recevier and using the provided 8x48-2 x 1/2" torx screw (#2), tighten using the appropriate torx driver to the receiver as seen in (Figure 1c).

## Stock Tube to Elite Mount Installation



Take the buffer tube and install the 8-32 square nut (#3) into the buffer tube bottom slot as seen in (Figure 2a).

Next press the square nut until you can see it centered in the buffer tube as shown in (Figure 2b).



Install the buffer tube into the rear of the mount as seen in (Figure 2c) making sure the hole in the tube and mount line up.



Turn the firearm over and using the provided 8-32 x 5/8" button head cap screw (#1) insert into the bottom hole of the elite mount as seen in (Figure 2d). Using a 3/32 allen wrench tighen the screw unitl seated as seen in (Figure 2e).
